

# AFC Waverton – Queens Field



**Pitch Address:** Common Lane, Waverton, CH3 7QT

**Directions:** Turn off A41 on to Eggbridge Lane. Take the first road on the right. You will go past the Primary school on your left and then turn left into the entrance for the Village Hall.

**Parking:** The large car park at the rear should be used first as the front and overflow car park on the multi sports area might be in use for other community activities.

If the Village Hall car park is full, there is a small canal-side car park further along Eggbridge Lane (turn right before the bridge) which has a pathway to the play area/back of the field. Alternatively, please park considerably along one side of Common Lane but please do not restrict traffic flow.

**Pitches:** Pitch 1 is an 11 v 11 pitch with fixed goal posts nearest Common Lane. Pitch 2 is a 9 v 9 pitch which is configured for different age groups using portable goals.

**Facilities:** The front entrance of the Village Hall must not be accessed by players and spectators as this is used as a Doctors surgery. Toilets for players (AFCW and Opposition) are available at the rear of the Village Hall which can be opened by AFC Waverton coaches but must be checked and closed at the end of the session. Changing rooms are also through this door however they are not currently in use due to Covid restrictions. **Please ensure all players using the rear toilets sanitise their hands before and after use, using the wall mounted hand sanitiser.** Spectators are not to use any indoor facilities but adults are allowed to accompany younger players if they wear a mask.

**Spectators:** Given the current social distancing requirements, each player is to be accompanied by a maximum of one adult spectator each and siblings only if no alternative childcare is available. Spectators should watch from their cars where possible and if not, follow Government Guidelines for social distancing and not congregate in groups of more than 6. We appreciate that everyone wants to watch the match but just want to keep the fixtures going for as long as possible.

**First Aid:** All AFC Waverton Coaches have a basic first aid kit that can be accessed in the event of a need. There is a public access defibrillator at the front of the building with clear instructions for use. The rear changing room can be used as a first aid room in the event of a significant injury whilst waiting for emergency services but must be cleaned/sanitised afterwards. Access for ambulances is the entrance to the car park and someone should be stationed on Common Lane if an ambulance is expected to ensure clear access.

**Contract Tracing:** As this is a public venue, each club's coaches are responsible for keeping an accurate record of those present from their team/club at matches.
